He plays the drums, guitar, bass, piano/keys, flute, violin, harmonica, lap steel guitar, trumpet, trombone, alto sax, tenor sax, congas, and timbales.

His music is influenced by classic rock, classic pop, 80s sounds, and dance music of various kinds, with lots of percussion. He reserves the right to veer into neo-psychedelic, prog-like, or industrial-type influences if the muse desires.

There's a caveat—due to a spiritual awakening that led to channeling and mediumship experiences, he is also subject to severe schizophrenia symptoms, which limits his ability to perform live.

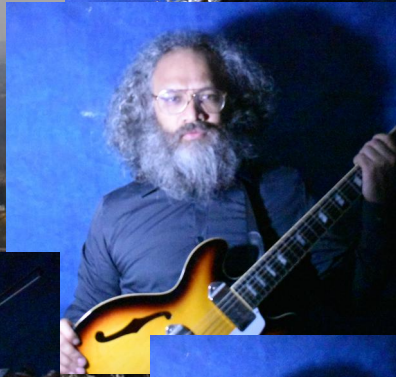
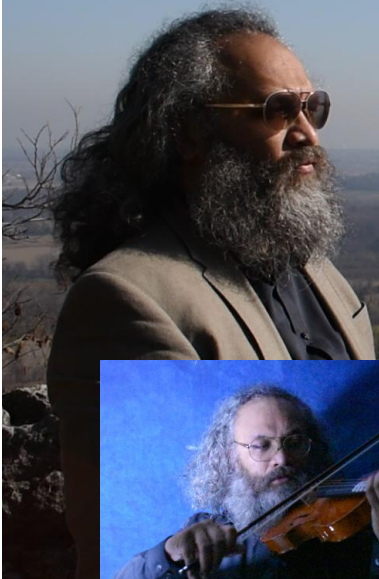
